Blanket Ministry, India

For several years now, *Global Action* has provided thousands of blankets for evangelistic outreach in Northern India and Nepal. Winter temperatures drop below freezing and many of the children run around with little or no clothes. In winter, 2013, Utter Pradesh experienced record low temperatures. We use these blankets in the slums of Delhi, Kolkata, and Lucknow and the surrounding villages like Motipur as well as in the foothills of the Himalayas and in leper colonies around Hyderabad. We gave out a total of 2,150 blankets. In addition, we gave out clothing and jackets to severely poor children, HIV patients, and throughout a leper colony. Part of the



blanket ministry was also supplying medicine to the sick and we saw hundreds come to Christ through these ministries. All of this was done through 32 of our GLOMOS alumni in 32 villages.



Medical Equipment, Nigeria

Working with The Salvation Army in Sweden, we were able to equip a children's hospital in Lagos, Nigeria, with much needed medical equipment. There are an estimated 10.9 Million* children suffer from malnutrition in Nigeria, approximately 33%* of them will die from lack of food. Thank God we are able to help them in a small way.

2013 LOOKING FORWARD

GLOMOS Training Program

This coming year we have 8 locations in 4 countries scheduled for classes. This has been and will continue to be our core focus. We anticipate the global impact transcending denominations, cultural and national barriers.

GLOMOS Annual Conference

This is ongoing education and support for pastors and church leaders in areas where we have GLOMOS students and alumni. We will begin to explore the opportunities for the United States and the United Kingdom to bring teams and ministers side by side with their national brothers and sisters.

India Hope Center

This is a community project with the core being the local church there. We are training pastors in the church as part of GLOMOS. We currently have the only Christian school in the area and expect 25-30 boarding students as well. The key is strong pastoral leadership with a vision to win and disciple new believers.

Ukraine Hope Center

The summer camps are the focal point of this center. However, we will be running some of these same programs as in the past. Our Christmas Festival and "Around Kerch" are two of the most effective programs.

Blanket Ministry


We use the blanket ministry as an evangelistic tool to help churches practically reach out to their communities. We have testimonies upon testimonies of salvations through the receiving of a simple blanket. Clothing and medicine are also part of this ministry to the disadvantaged and destitute.

Medical Equipment

Besides the outreach "compassion" aspect this gives Christians incredible influence and credibility within the countries we send equipment. We are planning to send containers into 3 countries where we work or where we want influence for the church in future areas of ministry.
