In a year where so many good organizations stumbled, Global Action was blessed with donors who continued to faithfully give. In spite of the pandemic, we were only down 5% from last year!

As missionaries living in Guatemala, my wife and I witnessed the significant withdrawal of so many foreign missionaries here. This phenomenon highlighted the incalculable value of equipping local leaders. Your prayers and financial support added tremendous credibility to local pastors and churches through feeding hungry families. Those pastors were able to pray and share the gospel with those who otherwise would not have heard the Good News.
