Dear friends,

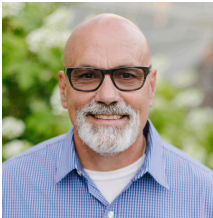

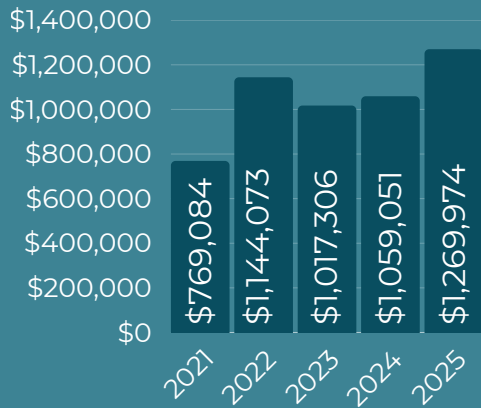
STUDENT SPOTLIGHT: RAMIRO BOJORQUES - MEXICO



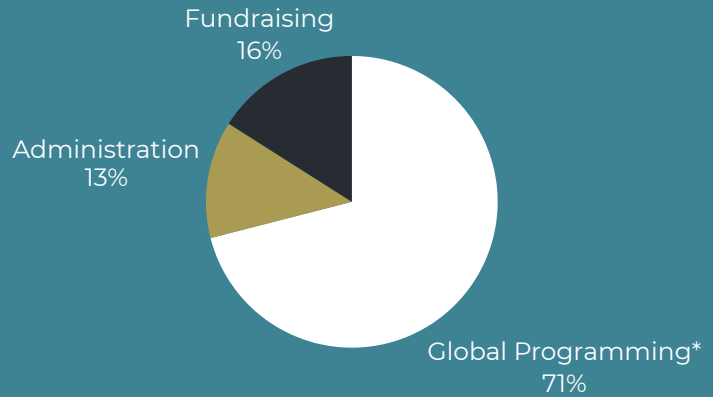
